Step One – Divvy Up

A. Decide who will work on which Act

- You should have 3 pairs and 2 people (the editors) working solo
- Might look like:
 - Zall & Oliver – Act 1
 - Hannah & Claire – Act 2, etc.

B. Distribute group scripts for each act appropriately

Step Two - Log In/Open iMovie

A Log onto the internet

B. Editors – (connect everyone to your account on the server)

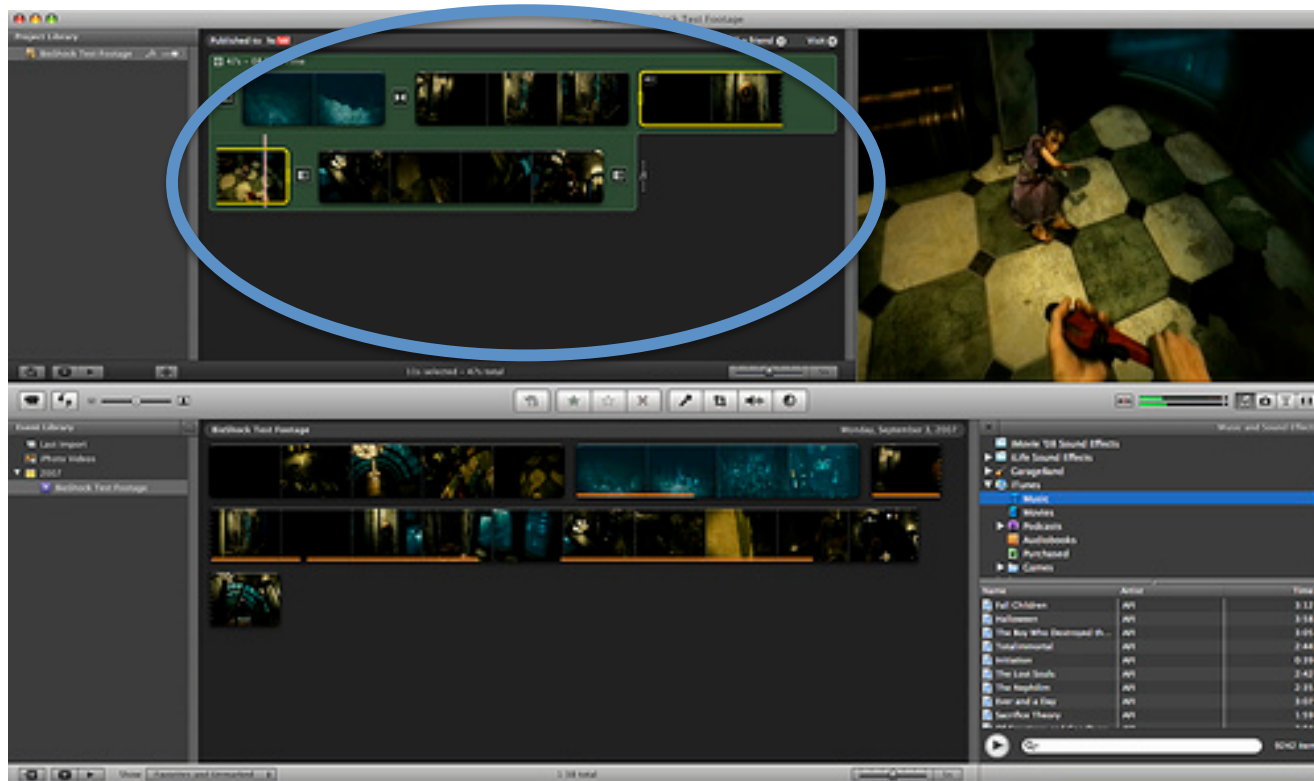


C. While you are waiting for your editor:

- Open iMovie
- Start a new project and label it “Act ___”

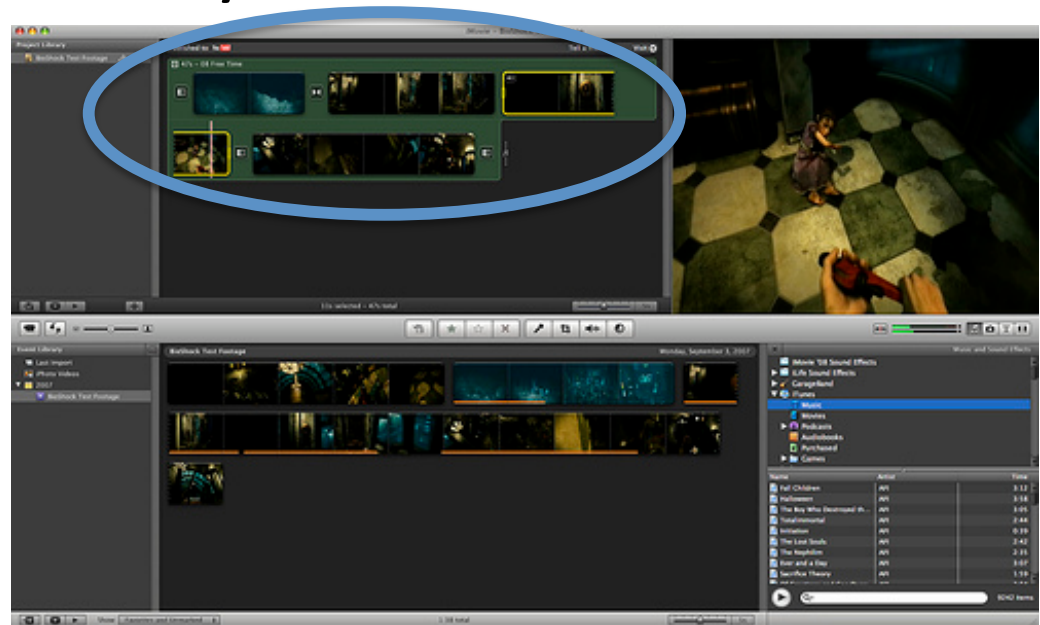
Step Three - Visuals

- A. Drag the photos for your act from the folder on the server into the top left part of iMovie.
- Make sure they're in the right order



Step Four - Audio

- Drag your audio into iMovie
- If your group saved as mp3, just drag and drop; it will show up as green behind the photos.
- If saved as GarageBand, you need to save as mp3 first.

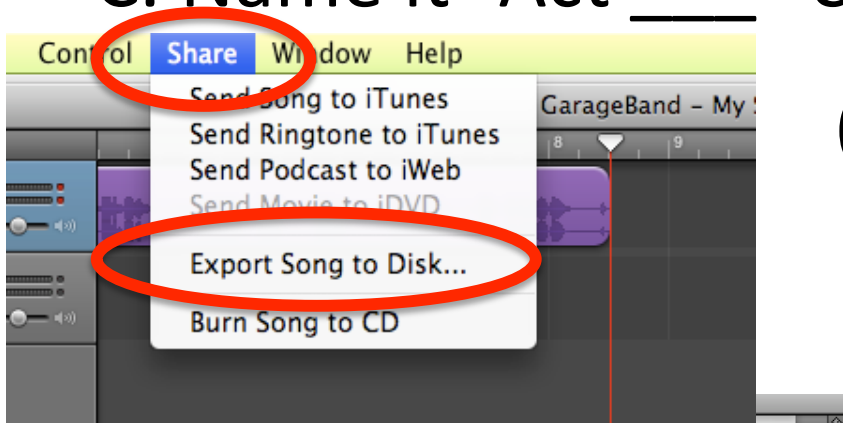


Saving as MP3

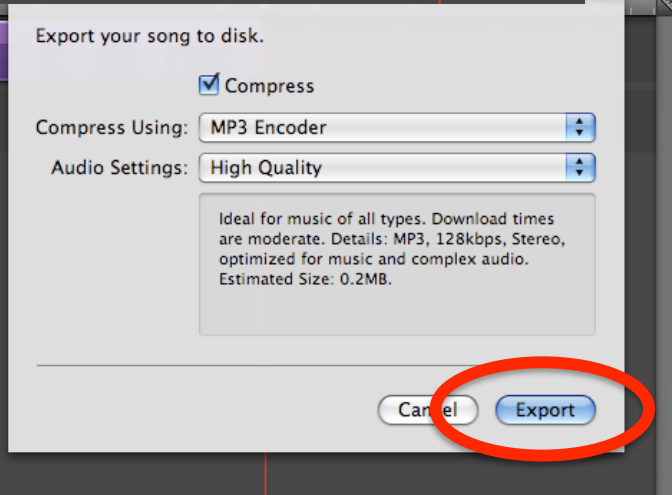
A. Open file in GarageBand

B. Click “Share”; “Export song to Disk”; “Export”

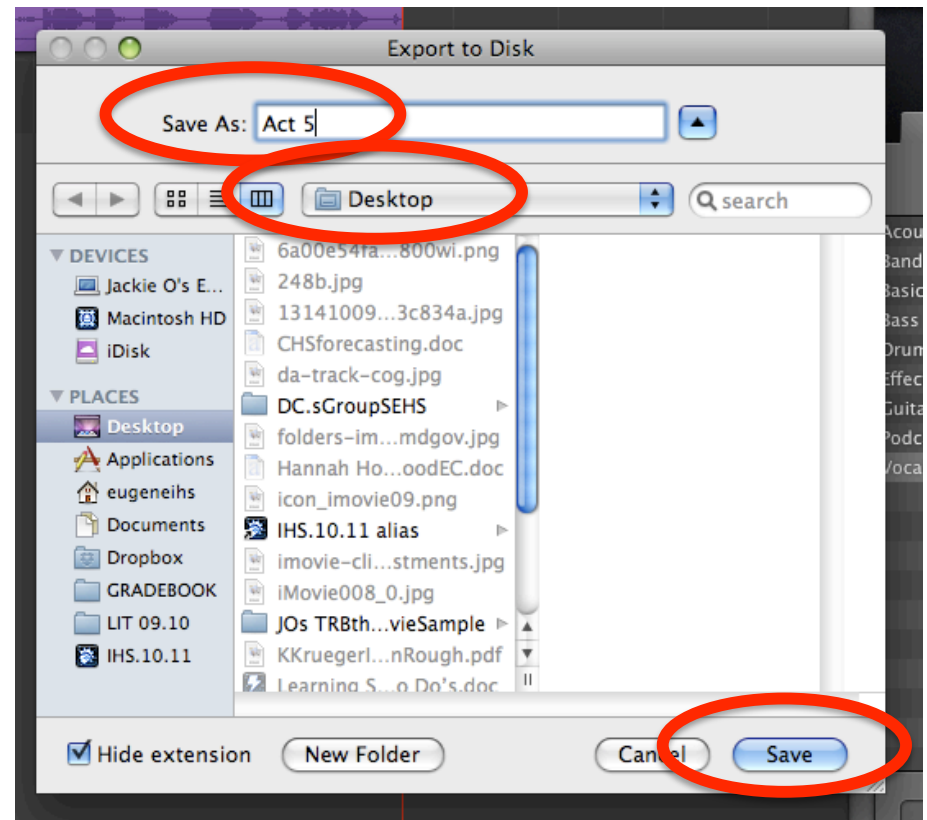
C. Name it “Act _____” & save to Desktop

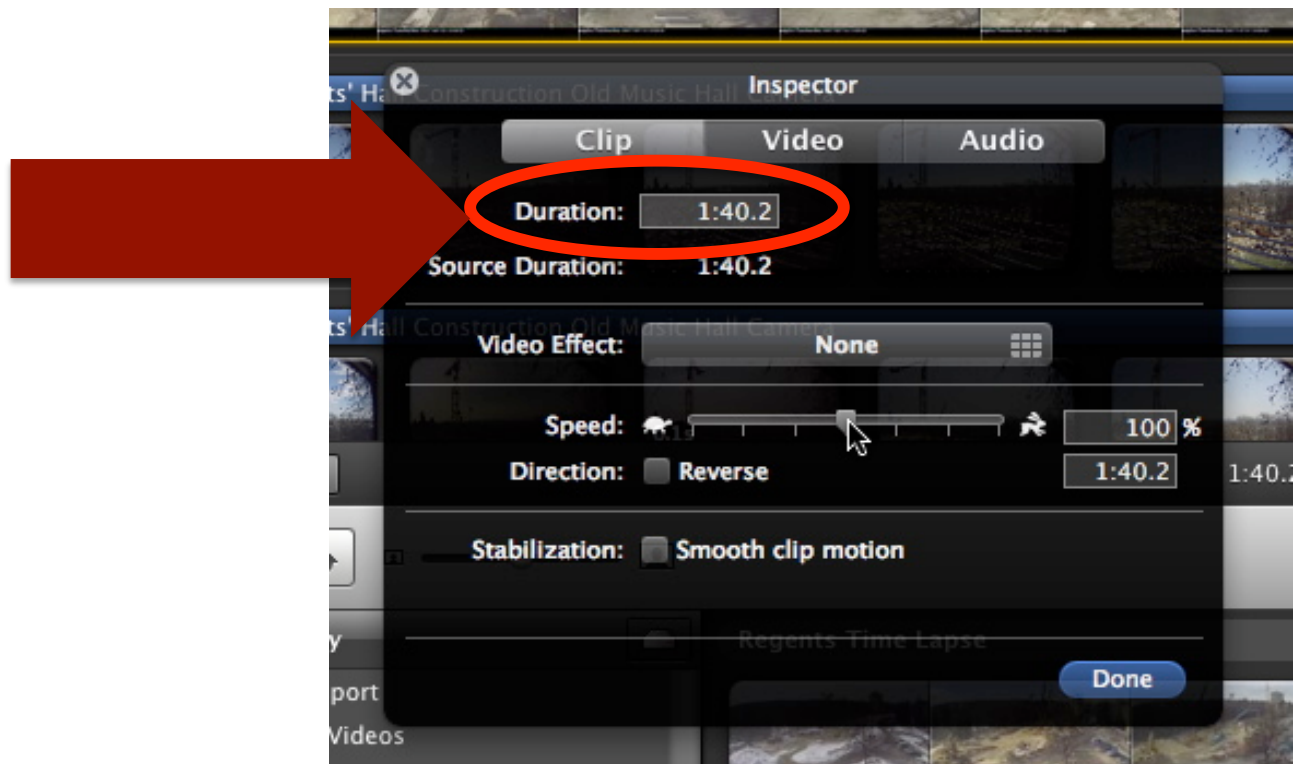
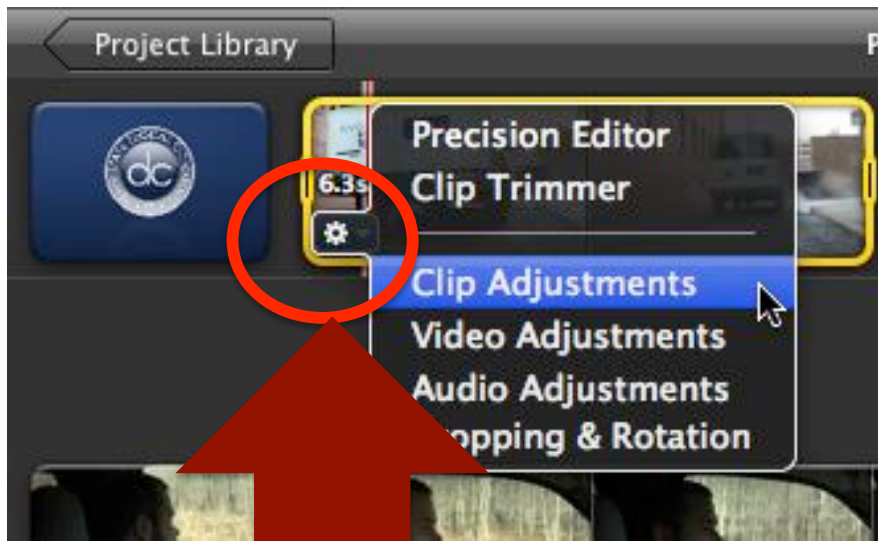




Step 5 – Audio + Visual

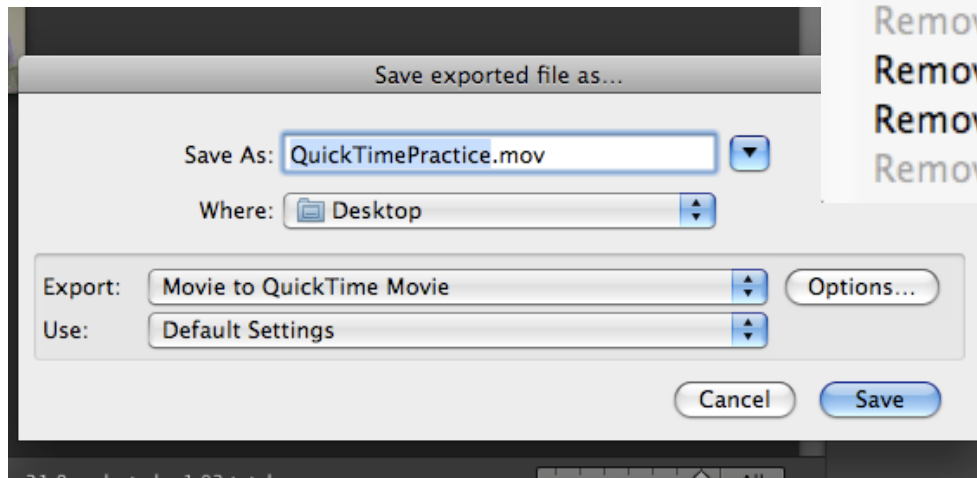
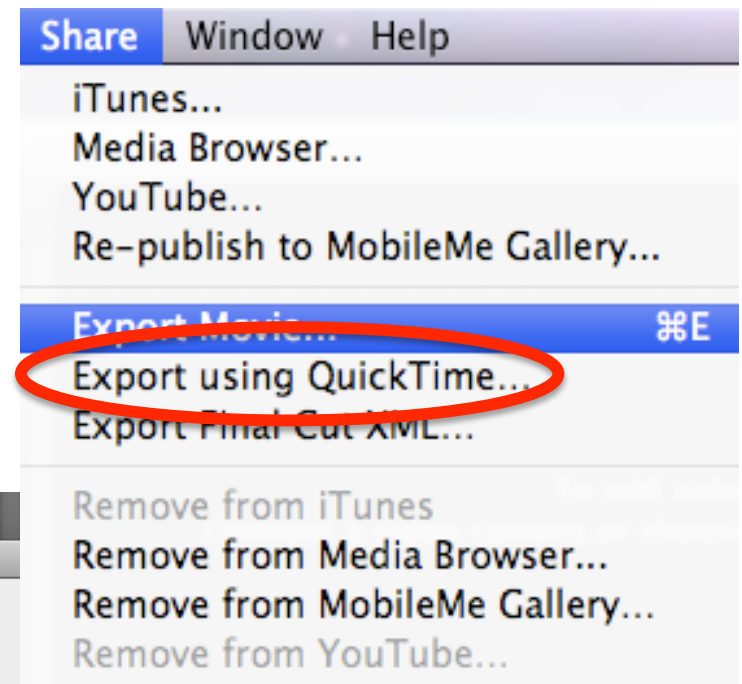


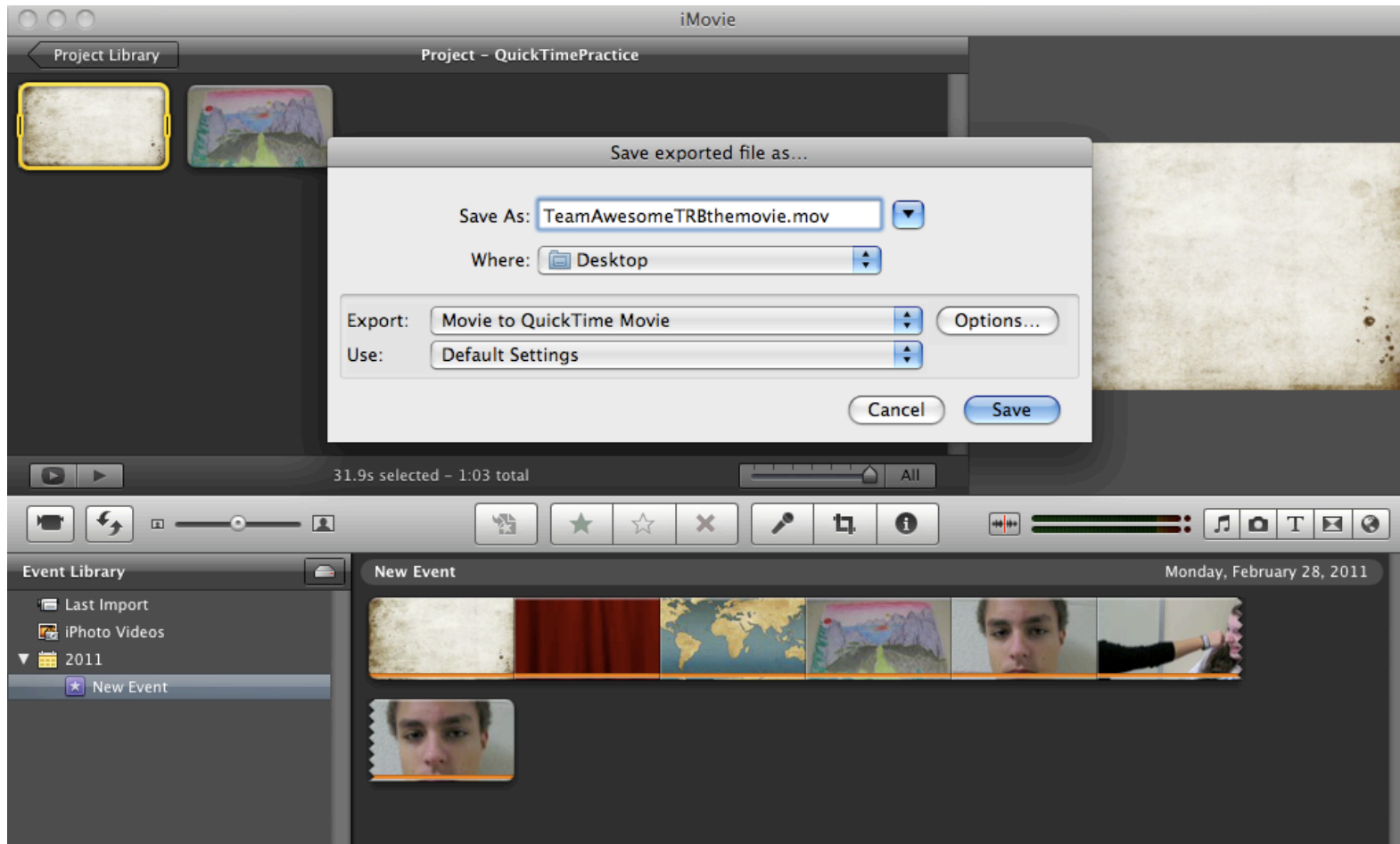
- Adjust the timings so that the time the pictures are on screen matches the audio.
- Use the cog button; hover over the lower left corner of each photo
- Click on “clip adjustments”
- Then change the clip “duration” as needed.
- You will need to “guess & check” until your pictures and audio match as best they can.



Step Six – Export & Share

- In iMovie:
- Click “Share”; “Export using QuickTime”
- Select “Desktop”
- Then, share by dragging and dropping your act into your editor’s folder on the server.





Step Seven – Acts Unite

- Editors –
- Create a new iMovie Project
- Give it a unique name for your group
- Drag and drop each Act from the server
- Click “Export using QuickTime”
- Select “desktop”
- Then, just drag and drop into your folder on the server.
